Stubbers Camping Visit

Required clothing and equipment:

- Towel
- Toiletries – i.e. shower gel/soap, shampoo, toothbrush/toothpaste
- Warm clothes – i.e. jumper, hoodie, waterproof coat. The evenings may be quite chilly.
- Sufficient clothes for 3 days. Please bear in mind that if there is wet weather, the children may need additional clothes to change into. Please do not send the children with their best clothes.
- Shoes/trainers. Ideally two pairs. If the weather has been wet in the lead up to the visit you may wish to send your child with wellington boots.
- Pyjamas
- Sun cream in case of sunny, warm weather.
- A hat/cap – It has been very hot on previous visits and hats were a must!
- Pillow and a sleeping bag, also a blanket in case it is cold overnight.
- A couple of carrier bags /black sacks – useful for wet, dirty clothes.

Non-essentials:

- Non-perishable snacks if you wish – although there will be plenty of food available.
- Sweets
- A small amount of money (Stubbers has a small shop)
- A camera (adults cannot take responsibility for these)
- A torch
- Card games such as Uno

Please do not send your child with:

- A mobile telephone
- Other electrical equipment
- Sports equipment, games etc.
